HEALTH HORSE DECLARATIONS:

Must be handed in on arrival. Blank forms can be found on SDC's website and will be emailed to riders with the draw.

COVID19 GUIDELINES:

Every individual at the event (riders/non-riders/helpers/grooms/club and committee members etc.) are to complete a Covid19 Declaration and sign the attendance register on arrival and departure. No one will be allowed to enter grounds until these forms are handed in. Blank forms can be found on SDC's website and will be emailed to rider's with the draw. All individuals in attendenance are to follow SDC'

Covid19 Safety Policy (can be found on SDC's website and will be emailed to riders). Each rider can only have <u>one</u> helper accompany them. At this stage <u>no spectators are allowed</u> (this is subject to change pending Covid19 restrictions - updates will be provided on SDC's Facebook page).

NOTE:

Entries to Preparatory classes are restricted to horse and rider combinations who have not won that class more than three times or ridden at Preliminary level or above from close of entries.

SPRAYING:

Is required for horses travelling south to Bangalow from QLD but not when returning to QLD.

CATERING:

Laneway Canteen Foods will be catering breakfast, lunch, snacks, coffee and cold drinks all day.

Conditions of Entry:

- **1.** This event will be run in accordance with the rules of the EA
- 2. All entries must go to Nominate.com.au
- 3. All SDC members who enter the event will be allocated a job
- **4.** Competitors must be current members of SDC to compete
- **5.** Current EA approved safety helmets must be worn by all competitors when mounted and lunging
- 6. Gloves must be worn at all levels when riding and lunging
- 7. Refer to dress & saddlery section of the current EA rule book. Jackets and plaiting are optional.
- 8. Horses can be ridden in two consecutive levels but no more than three tests per day
- 9. No horse can compete below its EA graded level (except HC)
- **10.** HC entries will be accepted at normal entry fee
- **11.** Riders cannot ride more than three horses per day
- **12.** Horses can be of any height
- 13. Junior riders are under 17 years old
- **14.** Ponies must not exceed 149cm with shoes
- **15.** Tests may be commanded

16. Entries to Preparatory level are restricted to horse and rider combinations who have not won that class more than three times or ridden at Preliminary level or above from close of entries.

- **17.** Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times
- 18. No horses are to be led in the main arena when others are mounted
- **19.** No lunging in the main arena (use the designated lunging area)
- **20.** Only horses entered in the event are allowed on the grounds

21. The club's committee has the rights to alter the conditions of entry

22. Only ribbons will be awarded for Junior and Pony Divisions. Prize money is only given to the open class place getters.

23. Prize money is dependant on class numbers.

24. Champions must compete in both tests for their level and achieve 60% aggregate or better to receive championship awards.

25. Health Horse Declarations must be handed in on arrival (forms can be found on SDC's website and will be emailed to rider's before the event).

26. Covid19 Policy forms for each individual person must be handed in on arrival (forms can be found on SC''s webiste and will be emailed to rider's before the event). All attendee's are to complete the Attendance Register and sign in/out on arrival and departure. No one will be allowed onto the grounds without handing in these forms.

27. Do not attend this event if you are unwell or experiencing symptoms such as a cough, sore throat, fever, fatigue or shortness of breath. **28.** Do not attend this event if in the last 14 days you have been unwell, had close contact with someone with symptoms such as a cough, sore throat, fever, fatigue or shortness of breath.or had close contact with a known or suspect case of Covid 19.

29. Do not attend this event if you have been overseas in the last 14 days.

30. Anyone who is unwell should see a doctor in accordance with NSW Public Health Authority Guidelines and advise the event organiser as soon as possible.

31. Social distancing of at least 1.5m must be maintained at all times.

32. All attendee's are to sanitise hands on arrival and depature of the grounds. The club will supply washing facilities and sanitiser.

33. Do not touch other rider's equipment or belongings.

34. No sharing of food or drink.

35. If this event is cancelled or postponed 20% of the entry fee will be retained to cover costs. There will be no refund of money after the closing date of entries, except on production of a Veterinary or Doctor's Certificate within seven (7) days after the event - then only 10% will be retained to cover club costs.

36. In consideration of the SDC Inc accepting an entry, riders and/or owners will undertake NOT to hold the committee or members of the SDC Inc responsible for any claims, losses, suits or damages. All riders and/or owners should fully understand that they compete at their own risk. Your signature on the entry form confirms that you understand and accept the conditions of entry.

37. This event is subject to change pending Covid19 restrictions.

38. Each rider can only have one helper accompany them. At this stage no spectators are allowed (this is subject to change pending) Covid19 restrictions - updates will be provided on SDC's Facebook page).
