



Summerland Dressage Club's Covid19 Safety Plan

In compliance with local and state health guidelines, our club requires all attendee's at club events to adhere to the following protocols. Please be aware that it is **your** responsibility to follow this plan.

1. All individuals are to scan the QR Code via the Service NSW App on arrival or sign in by hand on arrival at all events.
2. All attendees are to sanitise hands on arrival and departure of the Showgrounds. The club will supply washing facilities and sanitizer.
3. Do not attend the event if you are unwell or experiencing symptoms such as cough, sore throat, fever, fatigue or shortness of breath.
4. Do not attend this event if in the last 14 days you have been unwell, had close contact with someone with symptoms such as a cough, sore throat, fever, fatigue or shortness of breath or had close contact with a known or suspect case of Covid19.
5. Do not attend this event if you have been overseas within the last 14 days.
6. Anyone who is unwell should see a doctor in accordance with NSW Public Health Authority Guidelines and advise the event organiser as soon as possible.
7. Social distancing of at least 1.5m must be maintained at all times.
8. Do not touch other rider's equipment or belongings.
9. No sharing of food or drink. Hands must be washed/sanitised before and after eating.
10. The club will stagger ride timeslots as much as possible to reduce crowding.
11. All areas and equipment will be regularly cleaned by the club.
12. All attendees will have access to gloves, hand washing facilities with soap, water and sanistier at all times in the rotunda area and bathroom areas.
13. Any attendees not abiding social distancing and/or hygiene practices may be asked to leave the grounds.
14. All committee members are to abide the above rules when attending committee meetings.
15. All attendees (riders and non-riders) are to be fully vaccinated against Covid-19
16. Only one helper per rider is allowed on the grounds.
17. No spectators are allowed.
